

DGCA cracks whip on flying schools for lapses

Post Audit, Eight Instructors Have Been Suspended

Mumbai: Mandatory breathalyzer tests not being done, false logging of flying hours, operating faulty aircraft, poor training standards were some of the violations that India's aviation regulator has come across in a recent audit that covered 30 flying training organisations (FTOs) in India. Following a spate of accidents and incidents involving FTOs in India, the director general ordered a special safety audit of all FTOs, which began on March 21 and has covered all but two schools so far. The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has issued year-long suspension orders to two chief flight instructors and one deputy chief flight instructor. Apart from

this, three-month suspension orders were issued to two chief flight instructors and two deputy chief flight instructors, an assistant flight instructor and a student, said Arun Kumar, director general. A warning letter has also been issued to accountable managers of two FTOs. Apart from this, approval of one FTO has been suspended. "Enforcement actions against other individuals and FTOs are at various stages," said Kumar. The audit found that in some schools, student pilots were not appropriately briefed and trained on emergencies

and essential exercises before being released for solo flights or cross-country flights. In some FTOs, the instructors, student pilots and aircraft maintenance engineers were found to have skipped the mandatory breath analyser (BA) test, while in others the BA equipment was not in compliance with requirements, said the official. This is not the first time a DGCA audit has thrown up this violation. In September last year, during a similar audit, two FTOs were fined Rs 75,000 each for poor maintenance of BA equipment. Another area of violation was false logs. In a few cases dual flight was found to be logged as a solo flight, in other cases the time was calculated towards the instrument flying time of the student pilot, the audit found. Some FTOs were found operating aircraft with faulty fuel gauges, stall warning etc, while others had poor emergency response plan with obsolete contact details.

Cars collide in Delhi, 1 lands on homeless; two kids dead

New Delhi: Two children were killed and eight people injured after a BMW car, driven by an allegedly speeding businessman, hit another car, which flipped and landed on a group of homeless people sleeping under the Lodhi area flyover on June 10. Police said on Thursday they have arrested driver Sahil, reports Abhay. They said around 4:30 pm, a 530-hp Wagon R was crossing the intersection. The Wagon R flipped and fell. Two children—Roshni (6) and her brother Amir (10)—died. Those injured included including four occupants of the Wagon R. Amir's grandfather, Mohammad Islam, told TOI that over 30 people were sleeping under the flyover when the Wagon R first rammed a pillar and then injured a husband-wife couple and his son, Mohammad Jahangir. Amir and Roshni were sleeping next to each other. The car fell on Amir whereas Roshni was dragged by the car. Amir's younger sister, Khushi, also got trapped under the vehicle but was rescued by their mother, Abida. Jahangir, the children's father, works as a waiter and sometimes pulls a rickshaw to earn a livelihood.

Bihar trail leads to Noida's 'Chinese bar'

Noida: From the international border at Sitamarhi in Bihar where two Chinese nationals were arrested for trying to get into Nepal illegally last week, the trail of investigation has now run to the manured command of a plush Chinese club, complete with lodgings, a gaming parlour and a swimming pool, at a Greater Noida village. Designed to cater to Chinese expats living and working in NCR, the club—which police said was illegal as it didn't have the required licences—was run by Xue Fei, a 36-year-old Chinese national who came to India on a business visa in 2019 and has been staying here illegally since July 2020. Xue Fei and his Indian partner Petekhrino (22) were arrested earlier this week after interrogation of the two Chinese nationals held in Sitamarhi—Yung Hai Lung (34) and Lo Lung (28) —

Printouts of an Indian passport and a voter ID with Chinese national Xue Fei's photos on them were found in the Mercedes car he drove, triggering a forgery probe by police and central agencies, reports Advitya Bahl. Sources in the intelligence bureau said both printouts had Xue Fei's photos but an Indian citizen's name on them. by the Saschastra Seema Bal revealed they had stayed for 15 days at the rented apartment Xue Fei and Petekhrino shared in Greater Noida. Police said on Thursday they had detained six of the club's employees for questioning. The club, Tianshang Renjian, operated from an airconditioned three-storey building with still parking inside a leafy compound at Garhbarra village.
